Sub: Renewal of permission for MBBS course for 4th batch (150 seats) of Dr. M.K. Shah Medical College & Research Centre, Ahmedabad, Gujarat under Gujarat University, Gujarat u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 to be read with section 61(2) of the NMC Act, 2019 for the academic year 2019-20.

Sir/Madam,

This is with reference to the letter No. NMC/MCI/34(41)(R-69)/2019-Med./ 123244 dated 24.09.2020 and your letter dated 25.09.2020 submitting the required affidavit for renewal of permission for admission of 4th batch of 150 MBBS students at Dr. M.K. Shah Medical College & Research Centre, Ahmedabad, Gujarat under Gujarat University, Gujarat submitted u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 to now dissolved Board of Governors in Supersession of the Medical Council of India. It is brought to your notice that the Central Government has on 24th September 2020 notified fully the NMC Act, 2019. Section 61(2) of the NMC Act, 2019 provides as under:

"Notwithstanding the repeal of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956, the educational standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder."

2. Accordingly your application was processed u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 and Establishment of New Medical Colleges Regulations, 1999. I am directed to convey the permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board of the National Medical Commission for renewal of permission for admission of 4th batch 150 MBBS students of Dr. M.K. Shah Medical College & Research Centre, Ahmedabad, Gujarat u/s 28 read with section 61(2) of NMC Act, 2019 for the academic year 2020-21 subject to establishment of BSL-2 Lab facilities for testing of COVID-19 patients.

3. The next batch of students in the MBBS course shall be admitted only after permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board of the National Medical Commission for renewal as per regulations that would be framed under section 26 and 28 of the NMC Act, 2019.

4. Admissions made in violation of the above condition will be treated as irregular and action will be initiated under NMC Act and regulations made there under.
5. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of the Medical Assessment & Rating Board and the State Government.
